**Speakers - Dr. Andrew J. Bock, DDS. Board Certified Prosthodontist  
and Dr. Nicholas Shumaker, DDS, Board Certified Periodontist**



**Dr. Andrew Bock Bio** - Dr. Andy Bock attended Loma Linda School of Dentistry, then received his Certificate in Prosthodontics at the University of Texas Health Science Center. Dr. Bock is Northern Colorado's only Board-Certified prosthodontist. He holds memberships with the American College of Prosthodontists, the Academy of Osseointegration, the American Dental Association, the Colorado Dental Association, as well as the Larimer County Dental Society. His continued dedication to the field of Prosthodontics and the memberships he belongs to enable him to lifelong learning and furthering himself.

**Dr. Nick Shumaker Bio** - Dr. Nick Shumaker grew up in Northern Colorado. After attending Creighton University for undergrad, he graduated with honors from the University of Colorado School of Dentistry in 2001.

*Dr. Shumaker spent the first 10 years of his career as an officer in the United States Navy Dental Corps. This included practicing general dentistry for four years, and completion of a one-year Advanced Education in General Dentistry residency (AEGD). In 2008 he completed a 3-year residency in Periodontics and Dental Implant Surgery at Bethesda Naval Hospital in Maryland. In 2011, Dr. Shumaker moved his family and practice back home to Northern Colorado and joined Northern Colorado Periodontics.*

*Dr. Shumaker is double board-certified by the American Board of Periodontology and Dental Implant Surgery, as well as the International Congress of Oral Implantologists, holding diplomate status with both organizations. He holds a postgraduate Master's degree in oral biology from The George Washington University and has published several articles in the field of periodontics in peer-reviewed journals. He has been honored to be repeatedly named one of Colorado's Top Periodontists by 5280 Magazine.*

*Since 2011, Dr. Shumaker has been the director of the Mountain West Dental Forum Study Club, LLC, as well as the director of the Rocky Mountain Dental Hygiene Study Club, LLC. These organizations offer an annual curriculum of continuing education for doctors and hygienists, and in 2020 he was recognized by the Seattle Study Club as Study Club Director of the Year.*

## Program- Perio-Pros Treatment Planning - An Interactive Learning Experience

Attendees will be divided up into small groups where each group will have the opportunity to put together a proposed treatment solution. After a large group discussion of each groups proposed plan, the treatment solution applied to this case will be presented, along with additional lecture from the presenters on various treatment options.

- Refine skills in diagnosis, prognosis, treatment sequencing, and treatment planning in an interdisciplinary setting.
- Learn from and with your colleagues, sharing collective experience and training.
- Learn about techniques and treatment approaches from restorative care to specialty procedures, their applications and limitations relative to a clinical case.
- Receive input on patient factors and maintenance issues relevant in the long term for complex cases.

**Speaker - Dr. Monte Zysset, Board certified oral surgeon**

*Dr. Monte Zysset Bio - Dr. Zysset was raised in the Sandhills of Nebraska near the town of Valentine. He received his undergraduate degree from Midland Lutheran College in Fremont, Nebraska in 1980. Dr. Zysset received his Doctorate of Dental Surgery in 1984 from the University of Nebraska Dental College. He then completed a hospital-based, general practice residency, at the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio. In 1986, Dr. Zysset began a four-year Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Residency at the University of Oregon Health Sciences University in Portland, Oregon. His training provided extensive experience in orthognathic reconstructive facial aesthetic surgery, dental implants and facial trauma. Dr. Zysset is a board-certified surgeon, a diplomat of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons.*

*Dr. Zysset is the current president of the Nebraska Dental Association.*
